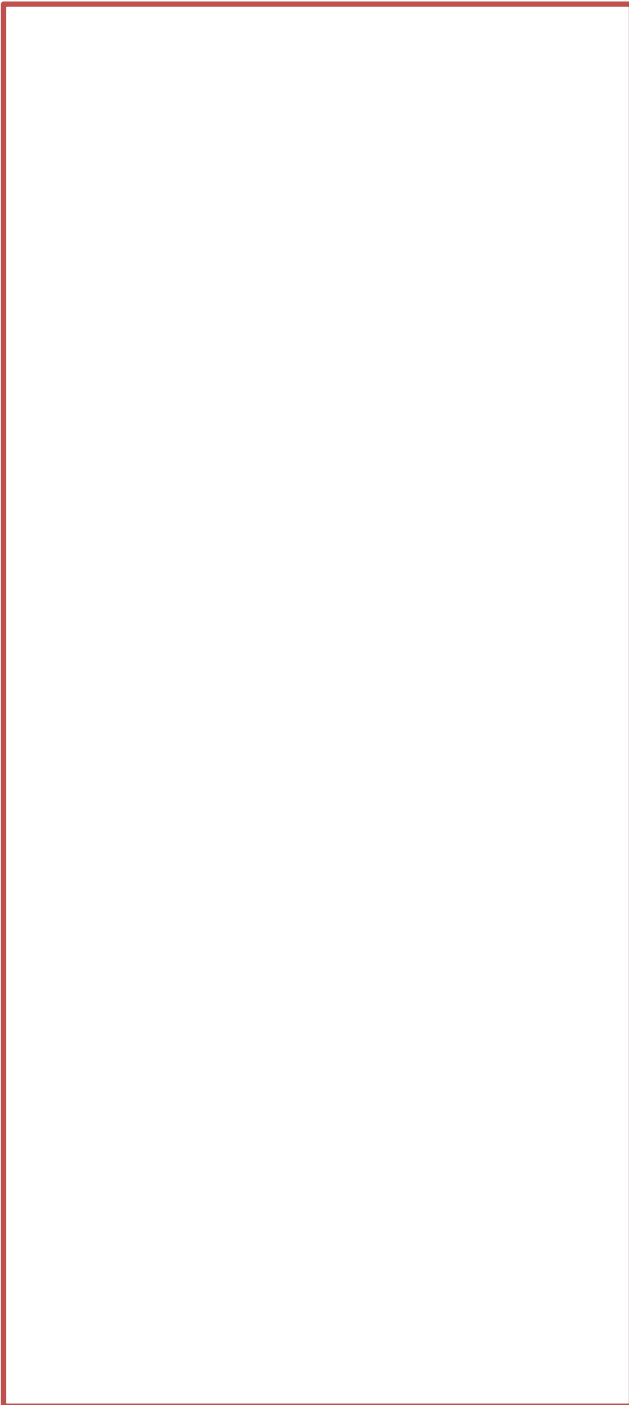

Accident Checklist

-KEEP THIS IN YOUR GLOVE BOX-

1. GET SAFE

- Turn your hazard lights on.
- If you can, get to a safe area.
- Be careful when exiting the vehicle, check for oncoming traffic and any hazards.

2. GET HELP

CALL 911 IF ANYONE IS INJURED!

Check to see if anyone has been hurt, if possible provide first aid.

3. GET INFORMATION

Use this packet to take notes, and gather important information.

Quick Tips



Take photos

- Use your phone or camera to take photos of the scene.



Don't Admit Fault

- You need to be trained to legally determine "Fault". If you admit fault, it can be held against you.

MONTANA LAW STATES:

- You have the legal right to use the repair shop of your choice.
- No one can require you to go to any particular shop against your wishes, for repairs or an estimate
- There is no law requiring you to obtain more than one estimate.
- You have the right to choose your tow truck
- Ask the tow truck driver to take your vehicle directly to your chosen repair facility, in order to avoid additional costs.
